

Handling pre-IIA applications for registrations and notifications on changes lodged with SROs

- To ensure a smooth transition, critical dates in relation to SROs' handling of applications and notifications are aligned as far as possible and illustrated below so that it is clear and easy for practitioners to understand.
- Coordinated publicity arrangements/messages in this regard will be rolled out nearer the time.
- Applicants and existing insurance intermediaries will be reminded that IIA will not takeover applications or notifications not completely handled by SROs. In that case, SROs will inform them to submit new applications or notifications to IIA on or after the D-day (which shall mean the day from which the IIA's statutory licensing regime for insurance intermediaries commences and SROs cease to be the self-regulatory bodies for insurance intermediaries).
